

Photography Competition Guidelines

There will be two different categories that will be given an award. Deadlines for each category is March 31st of the current Scouting year unless otherwise posted. Entries must be handed to a section leader who then can pass it on to the judge. If the judge feels there are two or more pictures that are tied for first, they will bring together a panel of leaders who represent each of the sections to vote on the best pictures that have been presented. The photographers in this competition must be 26 years of age or younger. However if the judge or judges of the completion is in this age category they must step down from judging if they wish to participate in this competition. The first category is a person/persons picture.

The pictures in this category may only be taken at **scouting events**. They can be from an ordinary meeting to a Jamboree. Each of the pictures taken in this category must provide the following details:

- Date/Location of where the picture was taken.
- Name of photographer.

The photos in this competition might be used to promote scouting. If this is the case then the photographer and individuals taken in the photo will be contacted before the photo will be released.

The second category is a nature or scenery picture.

These pictures can be taken anytime and anywhere. The pictures are not allowed to be altered in any fashion. If they appear to be photo shopped or digitally edited in any fashion the picture will be held for question with a panel of leaders. Photos that will not count in this category will be pictures that have a car or building within the photo. Pictures in this category must come as close as possible in a natural setting. This category also allows the photographer to take pictures of wildlife if they choose as well. In this category the pictures must have the individuals name attached to the photo.
